### DAY 01 – Arrival and stay in Colombo

Upon arrival at Bandaranaike International Airport, guests are greeted by a dedicated driver for a seamless private transfer to the hotel in Colombo. The journey spans 45 minutes to 1 hour based on traffic. Depending on your flight arrival time, you can explore historic landmarks or relax at the hotel.

## DAY 02 — Tee time at Colombo Golf Club & City Exploration

After breakfast, head to Colombo Golf Club, Sri Lanka's oldest golf course (established 1879). Tee off on its 18-hole, par -71 course (6,092 yards) designed by Paul Jensen, featuring Tifeagle grass greens and crabgrass fairways. Enjoy complementary lunch at the Club house.



Explore Colombo's markets or malls like One Galle Face or Liberty Plaza. Stroll along the iconic seaside promenade at Galle Face Green known for its street food, kite flying and ocean views.

#### Dinner and overnight stay at a 4-Star Hotel in Colombo

### DAY 03 - Travel to Nuwara Eliya

Begin with a morning visit to Gangaramaya Temple, Colombo's iconic Buddhist complex blending Sri Lankan, Thai, Indian and Chinese architectural styles. Explore its museum housing global Buddha statues including the island's smallest and stroll through the serene Seema Malaka meditation hall on Beira Lake.

Afterward, embark on a scenic 4-hour drive to Nuwara Eliya, Sri Lanka's "Little England" passing tea plantations and misty valleys. Check into your hotel in Nuwara Eliya and relax.

## Dinner and overnight stay at a 4-Star Hotel in Nuwara Eliya

### DAY 04— Golf at Nuwara Eliya Golf Club & City Sightseeing

Enjoy a round of golf at the Nuwara Eliya Golf Club, a historic 18-hole course (6200 ft elevation) founded in 1889, offering lush fairways and colonial-era charm. The day combines cultural immersion with alpine tranquility, ideal for travelers seeking both heritage and outdoor adventure. Enjoy complimentary lunch at the Club house.



In the afternoon, visit to a nearby tea plantation or Gregory Lake, a historic artificial reservoir created in 1873 by British Governor Sir William Gregory, blending colonial engineering with recreational charm.

### Dinner and overnight stay at a 4-Star Hotel in Nuwara Eliya

#### DAY 05 - Travel to Kandy

After breakfast, depart Nuwara Eliya for Kandy, a scenic two-hour drive through Sri Lanka's central highlands.

In the evening, visit the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic (Sri Dalada Maligawa), a UNESCO World Heritage Site housing Buddha's sacred left canine tooth. Explore its octagonal Pattiripuwa tower, the Aluth Maligawa shrine and the Sri Dalada Museum, which chronicles the relic's journey from India to Kandy and its role in Sri Lankan kingship.

### Dinner and overnight stay at a 4-Star Hotel in Kandy

#### DAY 06 – Golfing in Kandy & visit to the Peradeniya Royal Botanical Gardens

Nestled in Digana, near Kandy, Victoria Golf Club is a world-class 18-hole championship course designed by Donald Steel & Co in 1997. Set within a 520-acre estate adjacent to the Victoria Reservoir, it ranks among the "100 Most Beautiful Golf Courses in the World" (Golf Digest). Once your round of golf is completed, enjoy a complimentary lunch at the Club house.



Then visit the Royal Botanical Gardens in Peradeniya, a 147-acre haven housing over 4,000 plant species, including orchids, spices, and medicinal flora situated just 5 km west of Kandy.

#### Dinner and overnight stay at a 4-Star Hotel in Kandy

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## DAY 07 - Travel to Hambantota

After breakfast, travel to Hambantota and check into your hotel/resort blending tropical gardens with oceanfront views. Unwind in its spa, infinity pool, or private beach or explore nearby attractions like Yala National Park or Mirijjawila Botanic Gardens (optional, additional charges will apply). Ideal for travelers seeking serene coastal relaxation paired with Sri Lanka's southern charm.

#### Dinner and overnight stay at a 4-Star Hotel in Hambantota

## DAY 08- Tee off in Hambantota

After breakfast, tee off at Hambantota Golf Club (adjacent to Shangri-La), an 18-hole championship course designed by Rodney Wright, featuring coastal views and challenging play.



Return to your hotel for a serene evening of spa treatments, poolside lounging, or sunset cocktails by the ocean. A perfect blend of outdoor adventure and luxury downtime.

#### Dinner and overnight stay at a 4-Star Hotel in Hambantota

## DAY 09 – Return to Colombo and Departure

After breakfast, depart Hambantota for Bandaranaike International Airport, concluding your Sri Lankan journey with a seamless transfer.

Optional add-on: Include a Colombo city tour enroute to the airport for last-minute shopping or sightseeing, if time permits/depending on the time of your departure flight.



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
